FORT A.P. HILL CONTINUES NOISE MONITORING STUDY

FORT A.P. HILL, Va. – Fort A.P. Hill is extending the noise monitoring study to Feb. 12, a test plan originally scheduled to conclude tonight.

Due to severe weather and its impact on technical equipment, the installation suspended the study Feb. 5, with the last shots in the afternoon. On Feb. 8, the study resumed at 6 p.m. and has continued as scheduled since.

The study is designed to replicate what people could experience if the U.S. Army Explosive Ordnance Disposal School is relocated here. The U.S. Army Public Health Command (Provisional) and EOD School teams have joined Fort A.P. Hill to conduct the study in response to community concerns.
