**BOARD OF EQUALIZATION HEARINGS AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC
ON MONDAYS AND FRIDAYS THROUGH APRIL 15**

Bowling Green—The Caroline County Board of Equalization will hold meetings on Mondays and Fridays through April 15 to hear appeals from citizens not satisfied with their real property value established during the recently completed reassessment.

The five-member Board of Equalization was appointed by the Caroline County Circuit Court upon the recommendation of the Board of Supervisors. The purpose of the BOE is to equalize real estate assessments and hear complaints of inequalities where property owners allege a lack of uniformity in assessment, or errors in acreage in such real estate assessments. The board also hears complaints that real property is assessed at more than fair market value.
