PROPOSED ADDENDUM ITEM

Issue: Application for Temporary Pump and Haul Permit
Agenda Item: Proposed for Addition to New Business as Item #11 A

Background: The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) has received an application from Mr. Danny Zinnecker for a permit to remove and transport sewage from 13295 Paige Road, Woodford. Mr. Zinnecker has a contract in place with Old Dominion Onsite, Inc in Ashland for temporary pump and haul services.

Approval is needed from the Board of Supervisors for the pump and haul permit.

Mr. Zinnecker has a valid construction permit for an alternative onsite sewage system at his new home, but the site is too wet to install the system. The house is complete and he would like to move in under a temporary pump and haul agreement in the first week of March. The requested time period for pump and haul approval would expire in June 2019.

Attached are copies of the VDH application, the OSE/PE Report for Construction Permit and a contract with Old Dominion Onsite, Inc for temporary pump and haul services.
