Summary: During a special meeting on March 13, 2020 to declare a state of emergency and discuss actions needed in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Supervisors specifically closed the library and the Caroline County Visitor Center and shut down Department of Parks & Recreation facilities and programs. The closure status of all other County buildings and facilities was left to the discretion of the County Administrator.

Requested Action from Board of Supervisors: Administration is now seeking authorization from the Board to reopen the library, visitor center and Parks & Recreation facilities and programs once adequate protective measures and operational plans are in place.
