Summary: Attached is a memorandum from Director of Public Works/Utilities Joseph Schiebel requesting authorization to purchase a replacement solid waste roll off truck (to replace a 9-year-old unit with approximately 420,000 miles) in the amount of \$196,630 through a Sourcewell contract with Mid-Atlantic Waste Systems.

Sourcewell combines the buying power of more than 50,000 government, education, and nonprofit organizations and holds hundreds of competitively solicited cooperative contracts ready for use.

Budget Impact: A total of \$196,000 is included in the Motor Vehicles & Equipment line item of the FY 2020/2021 Solid Waste budget for this purchase. Financing was included in the lease purchase financing approved by the Board of Supervisors in September 2020.

Requested Action from Board of Supervisors: Approve purchase of roll off truck from Mid-Atlantic Waste Systems in the amount of \$196,630

SUBJECT: ROLL-OFF TRUCK REPLACEMENT

The current budget has provided \$196,000 of funding to replace one of our roll-off trucks in our aging fleet. This truck is a 2007 Volvo and is used six days per week, hauling solid waste to the disposal sites.

This unit is currently Nine (9) years old, with approximately 420,000 miles and counting. It is also important to note that this unit is considered a severe service vehicle due to go off-road at the disposal sites.

The new unit is a 2020 Mack roll-off truck with an Ampliroll body. It will take approximately 180-240 days (6-8 months) to build and deliver the new unit once ordered. We recommend purchasing this unit through the Sourcewell contract (formerly NJPA).

The Board approved the financing of this unit at its previous board meeting. Therefore staff recommendation is to purchase the Roll-off truck through the Sourcewell contract with Mid Atlantic Waste Systems in the amount of \$196,630.00
