**Summary:** Chairman Underwood has requested that the County consider reallocating \$5,000 of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds it has designated for COVID-19 testing to the Rappahannock Area Agency on Aging (RAAA), now doing business as Healthy Generations.

**Budget Impact:** The County previously allocated \$170,000 in ARPA funds for COVID-19 testing. As of September 22, a balance of \$160,000 remains that can be utilized for additional testing of County personnel if necessary.
