VDOT HOT SPOTS IN THE FREDERICKSBURG DISTRICT

May 13, 2018 – May 19, 2018

Interstate 95 at Exit 118/Mudd Tavern Road Widening and Bridge Replacement Project

Crews are working to improve the interchange on Interstate 95 at Exit 118 (Mudd Tavern Road). The project will build a new I-95 overpass and improve on and off-ramps on Mudd Tavern Road, improve Mudd Tavern Road east of I-95, and Mallard Road.

Route 606 (Mudd Tavern Road)

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 606 (Mudd Tavern Road) at the I-95 overpass for interchange and bridge project construction and storm sewer installation. Flaggers will direct drivers through the work zone. Expect brief delays.

Mallard Road

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Mallard Road for project construction and storm sewer installation. Flaggers will direct drivers through the work zone.

Interstate 95 Exit 130/Route 3/Fredericksburg Interchange Improvement Project

Construction is underway to modify the ramps and traffic pattern at the Interstate 95 and Route 3 (Exit 130) interchange in Fredericksburg to enhance safety. Motorists will encounter the following lane closures near Route 3, I-95 at Exit 130 and/or the Central Park shopping area.

Interstate 95 Northbound Exit 130 On-Ramp

(New) Monday – Friday, 8 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. The Exit 130 on-ramp which carries traffic from westbound Route 3 to northbound I-95 will be slightly narrowed to allow crews to remove traffic barrier and paving. The ramp will remain OPEN. Drivers should be alert to construction crews and equipment working along the shoulder of the ramp.

Route 3 Eastbound at Carl D. Silver Parkway

(New) Thursday, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Expect a single lane to be closed on Route 3 eastbound near the Exit 130 interchange.

Route 3 Westbound at Carl D. Silver Parkway

Monday – Friday, 10 p.m. – 9 a.m. The right-most turn lane and the left-most turn lane will be closed on Route 3 westbound at the Carl D. Silver Parkway intersection for median work and storm sewer pipe installation. The Central Park main entrance will remain OPEN.

Interstate 95 Bridge Rehabilitation Project

Work is underway to improve the deck and substructure on several bridges located on I-95 in Stafford and Spotsylvania.

Stafford County: I-95 Bridge over Potomac Creek at mile marker 137

The I-95 bridges over Potomac Creek are located near Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway) at mile marker 137. Drivers can expect lane closures at the following dates and times:

- **I-95 Northbound:**

Monday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m.

- 9 p.m. – single lane closed
- 10 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. – two lanes closed
- 4:30 a.m. All lanes open

Friday, 9 p.m. – 7 a.m. Single lane closed

- **I-95 Southbound:**

Monday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 7 a.m.

- 9 p.m. – single lane closed
- 10 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. – two lanes closed
- 4 – 7 a.m. – single lane closed (All lanes open at 6 a.m. Friday)

Friday, 9 p.m. – 7 a.m. Single lane closed

Interstate 95 (Exit 140/Courthouse Road)

Work is underway to improve the I-95 interchange at Exit 140 (Route 630/Courthouse Road). The project includes building a diverging diamond interchange at Exit 140, relocating the Courthouse Road and Route 1 intersection to the south to align with Hospital Center Boulevard, and widening Courthouse Road to four lanes from Cedar Lane to Ramoth Church Road.

Route 630 (Courthouse Road)

Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Courthouse Road will be reduced to one lane from Austin Ridge Drive to Red Oak Drive. Crews will be working near the I-95/Exit 140 interchange.

Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Courthouse Road between Cedar Lane and Walpole Street for grading and pipe work as part of the widening project.

Ramoth Church Road at Courthouse Road

Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Ramoth Church Road from Courthouse Road to Dog Patch Lane for grading and pipe work. Flaggers will direct drivers in the work zone. Expect brief delays.

Reids Road at Courthouse Road

Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Reids Road to allow trucks to enter and exit the work zone.

Snowbird Lane

(New) Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic Snowbird Lane to allow trucks to enter and exit the work zone at Courthouse Road.

Woodcutters Road at Courthouse Road

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, single lane closures on Woodcutters Road between Courthouse Road and Cutstone Drive.

Wyche Road at Courthouse Road

(New) Tuesday – Wednesday, 7 p.m. – 6 a.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Wyche Road near Courthouse Road for pipe work. Flaggers will direct drivers in the work zone. Expect brief, overnight delays.

Monday – Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Wyche Road at Courthouse Road to allow trucks to enter and exit the work zone.

Stafford County Work Zones

Route 3 (Blue and Gray Parkway)

(New) Monday – Tuesday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect alternating single lane closures on Route 3 (Blue and Gray Parkway) at the bridge over the Rappahannock River for bridge repairs. Expect brief overnight delays near the work zone.

Route 17 at Exit 133/Falmouth

(New) Sunday – Friday, Route 17 northbound and southbound will be reduced to two lanes in each direction at the I-95 overpasses to allow crews to take soil samples for the upcoming Interstate 95 Southbound Rappahannock River Crossing project. The merge lane for vehicles entering and exiting I-95 underneath the bridges will be shifted inside by a single lane. Work zone signs and barrels will guide motorists through the work zone. Drivers are asked to use additional caution in this area as they navigate the work zone. Brief delays may occur at peak hours due to the reduction in travel lanes.

- **Northbound**
 - **Sunday – Thursday**, 10 p.m. – 5 p.m.
 - **Friday**, All lanes will reopen by noon
- **Southbound**
 - **Monday – Friday**, 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. – 7 a.m.

Construction on the [I-95 Southbound Rappahannock River Crossing](#) begins in late summer 2018.

Route 8900 (Centreport Parkway)

Sunday – Monday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect single, alternating lane closures on Centreport Parkway near the bridge approaches and on the bridges over I-95 for repairs. Expect brief delays.

Routine Maintenance

Monday – Friday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Stay alert for mobile lane closures. Crews will perform routine maintenance activities at the following locations:

- **Route 17** (Warrenton Road) – vegetation control
- **Route 611** (Hartwood Road) – vegetation control
- **Route 616** (Poplar Road) – vegetation control
- **Route 662** (Stoney Hill Road) – vegetation control
- **Route 1525** (McCloughlin Street) – pipe repairs

Spotsylvania County Work Zone

Interstate 95 Northbound at Exit 126/Massaponax

(Update) Tuesday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect a single lane to close on I-95 northbound near Exit 126/Massaponax at 9 p.m. followed by a double lane closure at 10 p.m. All lanes will reopen at 5 a.m. Crews continue repairs to the I-95 bridge over Route 1.

Interstate 95 Southbound at Exit 126/Massaponax

(New) **Wednesday – Thursday**, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect a single lane to close on I-95 southbound near Exit 126/Massaponax at 9 p.m. followed by a double lane closure at 10 p.m. All lanes will reopen at 5 a.m. Crews continue repairs to the I-95 bridge over Route 1.

Route 1 Northbound and Southbound

(Update) **Tuesday – Thursday**, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect alternating single lane closures on Route 1 northbound and southbound underneath the I-95 bridge for ongoing repairs.

Route 1 Northbound and Southbound

Sunday – Friday, 9 p.m. – 6 a.m. Expect mobile single lane closures on Route 1 northbound and southbound between Route 1486 (Market Street) and Fredericksburg City limits for milling and paving work. Expect temporary rough pavement and brief delays near the work zone. Virginia State Police assisting with traffic control.

Route 609 (Jim Morris Road)

(New) **Monday – Friday**, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 609 (Jim Morris Road) between Route 17 (Mills Drive) and Patriot Lane for pipe work. Access to driveways will be maintained for residents who live in this section of Jim Morris Road. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone. Expect brief delays.

Route 609 (Thornton Rolling Road)

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 609 (Thornton Rolling Road) between Route 17 (Mills Drive) and Patriot Lane for pipe work.

Route 628 (Spotsylvania Parkway)

(New) **Monday – Tuesday**, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Expect mobile single lane closures on Route 628 (Spotsylvania Parkway) between Route 1 and Leavells Road for traffic engineering work as part of the paving project. Expect brief delays near the work zone.

(Update) **Monday – Friday**, 8 p.m. – 6 a.m. Expect mobile single lane closures on Route 628 (Spotsylvania Parkway) between Route 1 and Leavells Road for paving work and line striping. Expect brief delays near the work zone.

Route 636 (Mine Road)

(New) **Sunday – Friday**, 10 p.m. – 6 a.m. Expect mobile single lane closures on Route 636 (Mine Road) between Route 1 and Falcon Drive for paving. Expect brief delays near the work zone.

Routine Maintenance

Monday – Friday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Stay alert for mobile lane closures. Crews will perform routine maintenance activities at the following locations:

- **Route 208** (Courthouse Road) – vegetation control
- **Route 620** (Spotswood Furnace Road) – other maintenance work

- **Route 301** (Richmond Turnpike) – litter pickup, shoulder repairs

Caroline County Work Zones

Route 301 Northbound

Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 7 p.m. Mobile single lane closures on Route 301 northbound near intersection with Route 608 (Lakewood Road). Crews will be patching the pavement and eradicating pavement markings ahead of upcoming paving work.

Routine Maintenance

Monday – Friday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Stay alert for mobile lane closures. Crews will perform routine maintenance activities at the following locations:

- **Route 17** (Tidewater Trail) – vegetation control
- **Route 30** (Dawn Boulevard) – ditch cleaning
- **Route 301** (Richmond Turnpike) – litter pickup, shoulder repairs

Caroline County/King George County Work Zone

Route 301 at Rappahannock River (James Madison Bridge)

Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane on Route 301 northbound and southbound near the James Madison Bridge over the Rappahannock River for a bridge maintenance project. Expect brief delays on the bridge and at the bridge approaches.

Essex County Work Zone

Route 17

(New) Thursday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating single lane closures on Route 17 northbound and southbound near the Occupacia Bridge and Laytons Landing Road for paving work. Expect brief delays near the mobile work zone.

King and Queen County Work Zone

Route 33 (Lewis Puller Highway)

(Update) Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. Expect mobile single lane closures on Route 33 eastbound and westbound near Route 610 (Elsom Mascot Road) and Route 14 (The Trail) for milling and paving. Motorists may experience temporary rough pavement. Expect delays near the work zone.

King William County Work Zone

Route 604 (Herring Creek Road) CLOSED

Herring Creek Road is closed to through traffic between Route 628 (Dorrell Road) and Route 609 (Smokey Road) to allow crews to remove deteriorated corrugated metal pipes from underneath the road near Dorrell Creek. Crews will then install new concrete pipes and endwalls. Signs are posted along the recommended detour, which is approximately eight miles: Rt. 609 (Smokey Road), Route 608 (Locust Hill Road), and Route 628 (Dorrell Road). Weather permitting, work is expected to be complete on Tuesday, May 15.

Lancaster County Work Zone

Route 634 (King Carter Drive)

(New) Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 634 (King Carter Drive) near the intersections of Carters Creek Road and Irvington Road for a mobile milling and paving operation. Expect brief delays near the work zones.

Lancaster County Surface Treatment

(New) Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Motorists should anticipate lane closures or alternating traffic with flagging operations on various, low-volume secondary routes throughout Lancaster County including the following routes: 702, 1005, 1007, 1008, 1009, 1011, 1024, 1025, 1038 and 1060 for surface treatment. Expect brief delays.

Mathews County Work Zone

Route 14 (Main Street)

Monday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. A single lane on Route 14 (Main Street) will be closed as needed between Church Street and Buckley Hall Road to allow crews to install new drainage pipes underneath the road as part of the Mathews Courthouse Area Drainage Project. A flagging crew will alternate, one-way traffic through the work zone. Expect brief delays.

Route 611 (Church Street)

Monday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. A single lane on Route 611 (Church Street) will be closed for construction activities as needed between Route 14 (Main Street) and Brickbat Road as part of the Mathews Courthouse Area Drainage Project. A flagging crew will alternate, one-way traffic through the work zone. Expect brief delays.

Northumberland County Work Zone

Route 200 (Jesse DuPont Memorial Highway)

(New) Tuesday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating, single lane closures on Route 200 (Jesse DuPont Memorial Highway) near the intersections of Old Glebe Point Road and Route 360/Northumberland Highway for a mobile milling and paving operation. Expect brief delays near the work zones.

Route 644 (Hacks Neck Road)

(Update) Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 644 (Hacks Neck Road) near the intersections of Lighthouse View Drive and Gonyon Road for a mobile milling and paving operation.

Richmond County Work Zone

Route 3 at Route 608 (Farnham Creek Road)

24 hours a day: Temporary traffic signals are installed in the work zone of an ongoing emergency pipe improvement project on Route 3 over Laton Swamp. Route 3 has been reduced to a single lane just west of the intersection with Route 608 (Farnham Creek Road). The temporary traffic signals control one-way, alternating traffic in the work zone until the project is complete. Project completion is May 29, 2018.

Westmoreland County Work Zone

Route 631 (Longfield Road)

Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating, one-way traffic on Route 631 (Longfield Road) near Route 628 (Pomona Road) and Route 630 (Treakle Road) for a paving operation.
