I-95 Northbound

I-95 Northbound

Thursday – Friday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. One lane and the shoulder will be closed between mile markers 138 – 135 located in the vicinity of Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway) for construction activities associated with the [I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension Project](#). *Friday night single lane closure will remain in place until 7 a.m. Saturday morning.*

I-95 Southbound

I-95 Southbound Ramps at Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway)

Sunday – Monday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. The I-95 southbound on and off ramps at Centreport Parkway will be narrowed for a mobile line striping operation. Drivers entering and exiting I-95 southbound at Centreport Parkway should be alert to a narrowed ramp and line striping vehicles. This is a mobile operation.

I-95 Southbound

Monday – Thursday, 6:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. A single lane will be closed on I-95 southbound at the bridge over the Rappahannock River located south of Exit 133 (Rt. 17/Falmouth) for a routine bridge inspection.

I-95 Southbound

Monday – Wednesday, 9 p.m. – 10 a.m. One lane and the shoulder will be closed between mile markers 138 – 135 located in the vicinity of Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway) for construction activities associated with the [I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension Project](#) . All lanes will be open to traffic at 7 a.m. Saturday morning.

Stafford County

Route 17 Northbound

Monday – Thursday, 7 p.m. – 6 a.m. **Friday morning. Intermittent full traffic stops up to 30 minutes between midnight and 3 a.m. for demolition of I-95 overpass.** Stopped Route 17 northbound traffic will be permitted to clear in between each full traffic stop. Virginia State Police will assist with traffic control. Single lane closures between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. Weather permitting, this work zone will repeat on this schedule on Oct. 15-18.

Route 17 Southbound

Monday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 10 a.m. **Friday morning. Intermittent full traffic stops up to 30 minutes between midnight and 3 a.m. for demolition of I-95 overpass.** Stopped Route 17 southbound traffic will be permitted to clear in between each full traffic stop. Virginia State Police will assist with traffic control. Single lane closures between 9 p.m. and 10 a.m. Weather permitting, this work zone will repeat on this schedule on Oct. 15-18.

Route 1 at Potomac Creek Drive

Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 2 p.m. and **Friday**, 7 a.m. – 12 p.m. Expect a right lane closure on Route 1 southbound near Potomac Creek Drive for construction of a new left turn lane on Route 1 southbound. Read the [news release](#).

Route 1 Southbound

Monday, 7 a.m. - 12 p.m. and 8 p.m. - Noon **Tuesday**, **Tuesday - Friday**, 8p.m. - 12 p.m. Expect a single lane closure on Route 1 southbound near South Campus Boulevard. [Courthouse Road widening project](#).

Route 1 Northbound and Southbound

Sunday – Wednesday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. Drivers should be alert to a mobile pavement marking and shoulder repair operation on Route 1 northbound and southbound between Hospital Center Drive and Truslow Road. Motorists will be restricted to one lane in the mobile work zone.

Route 17 near Fauquier County Line

Monday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. Expect alternating lane closures on Route 17 near the Stafford County and Fauquier County line to repair the bridges over Deep Run near Hartlake Road.

Route 628 (American Legion)

Tuesday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Expect alternating one-way traffic on Route 628 between Bowers Lane and Ellison Court for construction activities associated with the [I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension Project](#)

Route 1317 (Quail Run Drive)

Wednesday – Thursday, 11 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. Route 1317 (Quail Run Drive) will be closed to traffic for drainage pipe replacement. Following the overnight work, construction activities will continue during the daylight hours for the next several days, but vehicles will be permitted to pass through the work zone at these times.

Route 630 (Courthouse Road)

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. As part of the [Courthouse Road widening project](#), expect brief delays with alternating, one-way traffic at the following locations:

- Courthouse Road between Cedar Lane to Walpole Street and Austin Ridge Drive to Red Oak Drive
- Ramoth Church Road
- Snowbird Lane
- Winding Creek Road between Courthouse Road and Embrey Mill Road
- Woodcutters Road
- Wyche Road

Caroline County

Route 721

Monday – Wednesday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Drivers should expect brief delays on Route 721 from Route 301 to Route 630 (Newtown Road). Crews will be applying pavement markings in this area. A flagging crew will direct one-way, alternating traffic in the work zone.

Route 301 Southbound

Sunday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect single lane closures on Route 301 southbound for bridge repairs between the towns of Bowling Green and Port Royal.

Gloucester County

Route 641 (Tidemill Road)

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Expect alternating lane closures on Route 641 (Tidemill Road) at the bridge over Sarah Creek, which is located between Route 17 and Guinea Road, for bridge repairs.

King George County

Route 3 Eastbound and Westbound

Sunday – Thursday, 7 p.m. – 5 a.m. Expect alternating single lane closures on Route 3 between Route 610 (Saint Anthony Road) and Route 205 (Ridge Road) for pavement markings. Work is part of resurfacing and safety improvement project to create a smoother travel surface on several high-volume roads in King George County.

Route 218 (Caledon Road)

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Milling and paving, and shoulder widening in some areas. Part of a resurfacing and safety improvement project. Expect significant travel delays on Route 218 between Route 206 and 1.3 miles east of Indiantown Road, and between Route 301 and Route 206. **Motorists can expect significant travel delays and are advised to use alternate routes during work zone hours.**

Essex and King and Queen County

Route 612 (Lily Pond Road/Bestland Road) at Dragon Swamp

Beginning at 7 a.m., Monday a portion of Route 612 (Lily Pond Road/Bestland Road) at the bridge over Dragon Swamp will be closed for repairs and maintenance work. The bridge, which is located at the King and Queen and Essex county line, will remain closed to traffic until Friday, Oct. 11, while crews make repairs to the bridge as recommended by a recent safety inspection. Work is expected to be complete and the road reopened to traffic by 5 p.m., Friday, Oct. 11.

King and Queen County

Route 14

Monday and Tuesday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Drivers should be alert to a mobile pavement marking operation on Route 14 between Route 360 and Route 614 (Devils Three Jump Road).

A flagging crew will direct one-way, alternating traffic in the work zone.

Middlesex and Lancaster

Robert O. Norris Bridge Inspection

Beginning Monday week crews will begin conducting routine inspections on the Robert O. Norris Bridge located on Route 3 over the Rappahannock River. Drivers should expect single lane closures on the bridge **Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.** each day through Oct. 31. Automatic flagging devices will be used to direct drivers through the work zone.

Additional Construction Projects in Fredericksburg District

Caroline County

Route 646 (Fork Bridge Road): ROAD CLOSED

VDOT crews are replacing a structurally deficient bridge over Maracossic Creek on Route 646 (Fork Bridge Road). Motorists are encouraged to follow the posted detour route, which is approximately 7 miles, along Route 627 (Roundabouts Road/Mattaponi Trail) and Route 721 (Newtown Road). The bridge closed in September 2019 and is estimated to remain closed through December 2019.

Stafford County

Route 3 Business and Route 606 (Ferry Road) Intersection

Work underway to improve this intersection is estimated to be complete by the end of 2019. Motorists should be alert for construction activity on Route 3 Business and on Ferry Road between the CSX railroad crossing and Route 3 Business. Route 608 (Brooke Road): ROAD CLOSED

Brooke Road is closed to through traffic near Eskimo Hill Road. This is a Stafford County project to realign the roadway to improve safety and drainage. King William County

Route 662 (Sharon Road): ROAD CLOSED

Project schedule under development. Crews are repairing damage from Tropical Storm Michael. The project is reconstructing a slope near the road and replacing the culvert.
