I-95 Northbound

Exit 118 (Thornburg) to Exit 126 (Spotsylvania)

Tuesday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Single lane closure at mile marker 119 for bridge inspection at the Po River.

Exit 130 (Route 3)

Monday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. Single lane closure near Exit 130 for inspection of Route 3 bridges over I-95.

Exit 130 (Route 3) to Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway)

Monday – Friday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. Mobile single lane closure between these interchanges to collect soil samples as part of the [I-95 Northbound Rappahannock River Crossing project](#).

Exit 133 (Route 17) FULL TRAFFIC STOP

Wednesday – Thursday, 10 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. Starting at 10 p.m., double lane closures will occur overnight near Exit 133 for the [95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension project](#). **Between midnight and 3 a.m., there will be brief, intermittent full traffic stops to allow crews to remove an overhead sign.** All I-95 northbound traffic will be stopped up to 30 minutes at a time. Virginia State Police will assist with traffic control. If this work zone is cancelled for inclement weather, it will be rescheduled for 10 p.m. Thursday to 4:30 a.m. Friday.

I-95 Southbound

Exit 140 (Courthouse Road)

Monday – Friday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. and **Friday – Saturday**, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Single lane closure near the Exit 140 interchange for the 95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension project. Crews will be installing work zone barrier.

Exit 133 (Route 17) to Exit 130 (Route 3)

Monday, Midnight – 10 a.m. and **Monday – Friday**, 9 p.m. – 10 a.m. Single lane closure. Crews will shift work zone barrier as part of the [I-95 Southbound Rappahannock River Crossing project](#).

Exit 130 (Route 3)

Monday, 9 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. Single lane closure near Exit 130 for inspection of Route 3 bridges over I-95.

Exit 126 (Spotsylvania) to Exit 118 (Thornburg)

Tuesday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Single lane closure at mile marker 119 for bridge inspection at the Po River.

Exit 118 (Thornburg) to Exit 104 (Carmel Church)

Thursday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. Single lane closure between mile markers 111 and 108 for milling and paving. Access to the Exit 110 (Ladysmith) interchange ramps and Safety Rest Area at Ladysmith will remain open.

Stafford County

Route 1

Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure on Route 1 northbound and southbound between Route 17 (Warrenton Road) and American Legion Road.

Route 608 (Brooke Road)

Thursday, 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. Pipe installation. Expect one-way alternating traffic between Andrew Chapel Road and Raven Road.

Spotsylvania County

Route 1

Monday – Friday, 6 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure on Route 1 northbound and southbound between Caroline County and the City of Fredericksburg.

Route 17

Monday – Wednesday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure on Route 17 between Route 17 (Mills Drive) and Supply Road in Caroline County.

Route 208 (Lake Anna Parkway)

Monday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mobile, single lane closure for pothole repair between Louisa County line and Route 606 (Post Oak Road).

Route 208 and Route 208 Business

Monday – Thursday, 8 p.m. – 6 a.m. Lane closures at intersection of Route 208 and Route 208 Business in Spotsylvania Courthouse area for traffic signal work.

Route 601 (Lewiston Road)

Wednesday, 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Mobile, single lane closure for pothole repair between Route 208 and the Louisa County line.

Route 608 (Massaponax Church Road)

Monday – Tuesday, 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. Pipe installation. Expect one-way alternating traffic as crews install several drainage pipes between the I-95 overpass and Flippo Drive.

Route 608 (West Catharpin Road)

Friday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mobile, single lane closure for pothole repair between Robert E. Lee Drive and Lawyers Road.

Route 609 (Thornton Rolling Road)

Sunday – Tuesday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. One-way, alternating traffic between Route 17 and the Caroline County line. Crews will be placing pavement markers. Flaggers will direct drivers through the work zone.

Route 610 (Elys Ford Road)

Sunday – Tuesday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. Mobile single lane closure between Route 3 and Route 616 (US Ford Road). Crews will be placing stone along the shoulder and pavement markers. Flaggers will direct drivers through the work zone.

Route 612 (Stubbs Bridge Road)

Tuesday – Thursday, 7 p.m. – 7 a.m. Single lane closure for repairs to bridge over Lake Anna.

Route 612 (Stubbs Bridge Road)

Tuesday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mobile, single lane closure for pothole repair between Belmont Road and Post Oak Road.

Route 621 (Orange Plank Road)

Sunday – Tuesday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. Mobile single lane closure between Route 3 and Route 613 (Brock Road). Crews will be placing pavement markers. Flaggers will direct drivers through the work zone.

Route 738 (Partlow Road)

Thursday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mobile, single lane closure for pothole repair between Morris Road and the county line.

Caroline County

Route 17

Monday – Wednesday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure on Route 17 between Route 17 (Mills Drive) in Spotsylvania and Supply Road.

Route 30

Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 7 p.m. and **Tuesday – Friday**, 7 p.m. – 6 a.m. Daytime pavement patching and overnight temporary pavement marking. One-way, alternating traffic between Signboard Road and Route 301. Road resurfacing scheduled to occur in mid-August.

Route 301

Thursday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile single lane closures on Route 301 between Route 17 and Lakewood Drive.

Route 601 (Cedar Fork Road)

Wednesday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure between Route 1 and Jericho Road.

Route 601 (Hewlett Road)

Thursday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure between Jericho Road and the Hanover County line.

Route 658 (Jericho Road)

Monday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure between Route 1 and Ladysmith Road.

Route 683 (CCC Road)

Tuesday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure between Route 1 and Jericho Road.

Route 689 (Oxford Road)

Friday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Mowing. Mobile, single lane closure between Route 1 and Jericho Road.

Essex County

Route 627 (Mt. Landing Road)

Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Alternating single lane closures on Route 627 between Fernlea Road and Rexburg Loop for paving, pavement markings, and addition of shoulder stone. A flagging crew will direct drivers in the work zone.

Surface Treatment: Town of Tappahannock

Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Crews will be applying surface treatment at various locations in Tappahannock. A flagging crew will direct drivers through the work zones at the following locations:

- Route 1003 (Essex Street)
- Route 1005 (Prince Street and Faulconer Circle Ct.)
- Route 1006 (Falconer Circle and Virginia Street)
- Route 1007 (Earl Street)
- Route 1050 (King Street)

King George County

Route 301

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Single lane closures on Route 301 near Owens Drive and Bennion Road for an [intersection improvement project](#). Located near Gate B entrance to Naval Support Activity South Potomac at Dahlgren.

Route 624 (Mathias Road)

Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Single lane closure for pavement patching between Osprey Road and Schoolhouse Road.

Route 692 (Cleve Road)

Monday – Friday, Single lane closure for pavement patching, milling and paving between Port Conway Road to end of state maintenance line.

King and Queen County

Route 360 Westbound

Monday – Tuesday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Drivers should expect single lane closures on Route 360 westbound from just east of Route 631 (Fleets Mill Road) to the Essex County line for paving.

King William

Route 600 (W. River Road)

Wednesday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Alternating, single lane closures on Route 600 (W. River Road) near Route 30 (King William Road) and Route 360 (Richmond-Tappahannock Highway) for paving.

Route 614 (Normans Bridge Road)

Thursday – Friday, 7 p.m. – 7 a.m. One-way, alternating traffic at King William and Hanover County line. Bridge repairs.

Richmond County

Route 3 (Historyland Highway)

Monday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Expect alternating lane closures on Route 3 (Historyland Highway) from just east of Route 614 (Folly Neck Road) to just west of Route 601 (Mason Road) for pavement markings.

Westmoreland County

Route 3

Sunday – Tuesday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Crews will be paving and applying pavement markings to Route 3 from just east of Route 1202 (Alma Lane) to just west of the Richmond County line. Drivers should expect alternating single lane closures in the work zone.

Route 202 (Cople Highway)

Monday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Milling, paving and application of shoulder stone near the intersection of Route 3 to the west end of the bridge over Nomini Creek. Alternating lane closures directed by a flagging crew.

Route 643 (Chilton Road)

Wednesday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. One-way, alternating traffic from Stratford Hall Road to Zacata Road for paving and pavement markings.

Additional Construction Projects in Fredericksburg District

Caroline County

Route 207 Southbound Bridge Replacement

Route 207 is reduced to a single northbound and southbound lane at the bridge over the Mattaponi River. Traffic is traveling in the northbound lanes while the southbound bridge is closed for a replacement project. The new southbound bridge is anticipated to open to traffic in July 2021, with all construction complete by September 2021.

Essex County

Route 620 (Dunbrooke Road)

Route 620 (Dunbrooke Road) is closed over Piscataway Creek for a bridge replacement project. The bridge is located between Route 642 (Purkins Road) and Route 622 (Latanes Mill Road). Detour signs are posted along the recommended 9-mile detour route. The road will remain closed until its anticipated completion date in November 2020.

City of Fredericksburg

Route 3 Business at Chatham Bridge

The Chatham Bridge is closed to traffic for an [improvement project](#). Drivers should follow the posted detour signs directing traffic around the bridge closure. The bridge will reopen to traffic in October 2021, and all construction work will be complete by April 2022.

Gloucester County and Middlesex County

Route 17 Southbound over Dragon Run

Route 17 southbound is reduced to a single lane for a bridge rehabilitation project over Dragon Run. The bridge is located at the county line between Gloucester County and Middlesex County. Project estimated completion is August 2021.

King George County

Route 301 at Bennion Road and Owens Drive

Construction began June 1 to lengthen several turn lanes on Route 301 in King George County at the intersection with one of the entrances to the Naval Support Activity South Potomac at Dahlgren. The project will be finished in November 2020.

King and Queen County

Route 617 (Exol Road)

Route 617 (Exol Road) is closed to traffic at the bridge over Exol Swamp while crews replace the structurally deficient bridge. Detour signs are posted along the 8-mile detour around the closure. The bridge will remain closed until November 2020. Click [here](#) for the recommended detour route.

Route 619 (Owens Mill Road)

Route 619 (Owens Mill Road) is closed for a bridge replacement project over Rickenaw Creek. Detour signs are posted along the recommended 10-mile detour route. The road will remain closed until its anticipated completion date, which has been extended to July 31, 2020.

King William County

Route 30 and Route 360 Intersection Improvement

Construction is underway to improve the intersection of Route 30 and Route 360. The project will build dedicated right and left turn lanes and through lanes for eastbound Route 30, and will modify turn lanes on Route 360. A sidewalk will be built along Route 30 to allow pedestrians to cross Route 360. The project will be completed in June 2021.

Route 662 (Sharon Road)

A portion of Sharon Road is closed for reconstruction following damage from Tropical Storm Michael. A project to reconstruct a slope and replace a culvert will be advertised to potential bidders in summer 2020. The road is anticipated to reopen to traffic by the end of 2020.

Stafford County

Route 1 at Potomac Creek

Construction began June 1 on a project to replace the Route 1 bridge over Potomac Creek in Stafford County. Route 1 will continue to have four travel lanes open during the project, with only periodic single lane closures required. The new bridge will be complete in July 2022.
