Caroline Deputy Receives 2020 MADD Award

Caroline County, Virginia – In September, 2020, Deputy Jesse Daily received the Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) award at the 2020 Annual Law Enforcement Awards Ceremony. The MADD award is given to a law enforcement officer that has substantially contributed to the reduction of impaired driving incidences in each locality. For 2019, Deputy Daily made 18 driving under the influence (DUI) arrests.

The MADD foundation has made a considerable impact on the nation since its inception in 1980. Drunk driving deaths have been reduced by 50% and 370,000 lives have been saved. In addition, MADD has served over 840,000 victims of drunk drivers. MADD's solution to the drunk driving epidemic is to increase law enforcement visibility, strengthening the requirements for ignition interlocks for offenders, and "ridesharing." The MADD foundation is against more than just alcohol related impaired accidents, it is also fighting against drugged driving.

Sheriff Lippa stated, "I am proud of Deputy Daily and this accomplishment. His commitment to remove impaired drivers from our roadways allows for Caroline County to be a safer place to live, work, and raise a family."
