CANVASS – JUNE 9, 2021, DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTION

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman John Nunnally, Gloria Taylor, and Cheryl Johnson.

MEMBERS ABSENT:

OTHERS PRESENT: Kathy McVay, General Registrar

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and determined that a quorum was present.

The Chairman stated that the Board would start the Canvass of Votes for the General Election.

Adjournment until June 11, 2021: The Board voted to reconvene the meeting to noon until June 11, 2021. Voting Aye: Nunnally, Taylor, and Johnson.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at Noon, determined that a quorum was present, and that Cheryl Johnson was not present, but would be arriving soon.

On Motion by Nunnally, seconded by Taylor, the Board voted to appoint Gloria Taylor as acting secretary until Cheryl Johnson could arrive and assume her duties. Voting Aye: Nunnally and Taylor.

The Board will be processing all ballots at the CAP for all ballots received after Election Day and by noon on Friday, June 11, 2021. The CAP Officers of Election Patricia Parker, Beth Newsome, and Kesha Buchanan processed the 5 absentee ballots that were received by noon June 11, 2021.

On Motion by Nunnally, seconded by Taylor, the Board moved that the Electoral Board of Caroline County convene in closed session pursuant to section [§24.2-653\(B\)](#) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of considering whether each person who submitted a provisional vote at the election was qualified to do so, and I also move that the general registrar and any authorized representatives of candidates or political parties, as specified in section [§24.2-653\(B\)](#), be allowed to remain in the room during the closed meeting, and that any persons who cast provisional votes and who are present be allowed to enter the room while their qualifications are considered and to present any relevant information on their behalf to the board. Voting Aye: Nunnally, and Taylor.

Nunnally, seconded by Taylor, the Board moved that the Electoral Board of Caroline County certify that in the closed session just concluded the only matters discussed were the qualifications of provisional voters, as directed by §24.2-653 of the Code of Virginia, and as identified in the motion to close the meeting pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act.

Nunnally Voting: Aye
Taylor Voting: Aye

On Motion by Nunnally, seconded by Taylor, the Board voted that the 2 Provisional Ballots received at the precincts would be counted. Voting Aye: Nunnally and Taylor.

Johnson arrived at 12:45 p.m.

CAP presented the SOR to the Registrar who recorded those on VERIS as post-election results for CAP.

Abstract of Votes – The Board decided that the Abstract of Votes would be signed on Tuesday, June 15th at 9 a.m.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m. Voting Aye: Nunnally, Taylor, and Johnson.
